Athletics-

Morey Middle School offers a variety of sports that students may participate in.

Physicals-

All participants must have completed a physical and a physical form signed by their health provider. All participants must also complete the section on "Athletic Emergency Information."

Eligibility:

Each participant must maintain a weekly grade of "C" or better and exhibit proper behavior in all classes. Any student receiving a weekly grade of "D" or "F" or exhibiting unsatisfactory behavior will be ineligible to participate in that week's contest.

Transportation-

Each participant is required to provide their own transportation from practices and home games. Buses will return to Morey only after away games.

Athletic fee-

Denver Public Schools require a \$25 fee per sport to participate in middle school athletics.
